

Electrical & Gas Contractor Authorization Declaration of Compliance

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide information related to a change in documentation required by the Township of Langley prior to granting an Accepted Final Inspection where electrical and gas works have taken place.

Effective April 2, 2018, all new single family dwellings, additions, renovations and accessory buildings where electrical and gas works have taken place will require the submission of the following forms from Technical Safety BC before an Accepted Final Inspection will be granted:

- *Electrical Contractor Authorization and Declaration*
- *Gas Notification of Completion, Installation or Alteration Form*

The Township of Langley does not issue electrical or gas permits and does not perform electrical or gas inspections. In the past, the Township of Langley solely relied on the owner or contractor to ensure gas and electrical inspections were completed by the proper authorities and the above-noted forms submitted to Technical Safety BC.

The requirement for the electrical and gas documentation to be submitted prior to receiving an Accepted Final Inspection is formalizing the process. The owner and/or contractor will need to provide copies of the noted forms to confirm the work has been completed by a licensed contractor and the work is in accordance with all provincial codes.
