**THIS RECIPE TURNS INTO PLASTIC
THAT CAN BE HUNG IN THE WINDOW
LIKE SUNCATCHERS!**

WHAT'S NEEDED

- one envelope of unflavoured gelatin
- 3 tbsp boiling water
- 3 drops food colouring
- measuring cups, measuring spoons, small saucepan for boiling water, plastic lids in various sizes, cake pan, drinking straws

FIRST

Have an adult boil some water. Empty one envelope of gelatin into a measuring cup and add a food colouring and the boiling water (grown-up helper time!)

THEN

Stir quickly until all the gelatin is dissolved. Lay the plastic lids in a cake pan (like the kind used to reseal potato chip tubes). Pour a little mixture into each plastic lid. For two colours you'll need two separate mixing cups, each with its own colour. Pour both colours simultaneously into a single lid and work quickly.

Let the gelatin dry for about half an hour. At this point, poke a hole for hanging with a drinking straw. You can peel the gelatin shape out of the lid now and cut it in shapes with scissors if you want, or let the gelatin dry completely before removing (this will take two days). Shapes will probably not dry completely flat, but that's ok! Be creative with the shapes and allow them to take on their own shape!
