## **BROOKSWOOD-FERNRIDGE COMMUNITY PLANNING TEAM CREATED**

Volunteers from a variety of backgrounds and interests have been appointed to a Community Planning Team that will work with the Township of Langley as it prepares a minor update to the Brookswood-Fernridge Community Plan.

In April, Township Council issued a call for nominees for the Team. On May 30, Council announced that 17 residents, property owners, business people, and representatives from organizations had been appointed to the Community Planning Team (CPT). The Team will attend meetings and workshops, review materials and ideas, provide input and feedback, assist Township staff, and report back to the community and their organizations during the minor update process.

“We were really pleased with the number of people who applied to serve on the Community Planning Team,” said Township of Langley Mayor Jack Froese. “It shows how many people are concerned about the future of this community and are eager to get involved.”

“It was difficult to choose from so many quality applicants, but we feel we have established a group that represents varied viewpoints and ideas. The Community Planning Team will be a great contributor to this process and provide valuable insight and feedback,” Froese said.

He noted there will be many opportunities for the public to get involved and have their say as the minor update is prepared, including community dialogue sessions, open houses, workshops, online engagement, and consultation summaries.
