What's next for the Fort Langley Community Park?

Langley, BC – What's next for the Fort Langley Community Park? With the existing outdoor pool nearing 60 years old, the Township of Langley wants to hear your thoughts on future amenities and learn more about how you currently use the park.

To encourage residents and community members to share new ideas and weigh proposed options, the Township launched a public engagement webpage and online survey in March. Engagement will continue in April to ensure community members, from all areas of the Township, have ample opportunities to participate.

The engagement follows a request from Township of Langley Council, and results of the survey will be presented to Council this summer for their consideration. In the meantime, the Fort Langley outdoor pool will remain closed due to health and safety reasons.

The survey and further project information is available at tol.ca/FLCPsurvey. The survey outlines park options and their possible impact on taxpayers, and the webpage details frequently asked questions and information on existing amenities and infrastructure such as the tree canopy, cemetery, and open spaces.

Residents and community members are encouraged to provide feedback by Friday, April 16.
