Water Main Flushing

The Township of Langley is flushing water mains this spring. Areas and dates are as follows:

- Murrayville: Until Friday, April 29
- Willoughby: Until Friday, April 29
- Yorkson and Northwest Langley: Until Friday, May 6

As a result of water main flushing, residents may notice temporary changes in water pressure.

While some discolouration or sediment in the water may occur, it is a temporary condition and is not a health hazard. To avoid inconvenience, residents may wish to check the water before doing laundry, and to keep water in the refrigerator for drinking and cooking during flushing in their neighbourhood. The work is weather dependent, and the flushing schedule is subject to change.

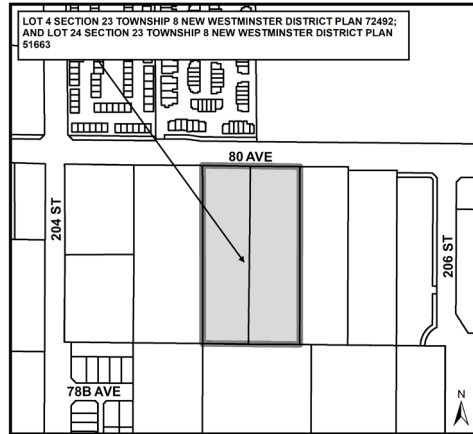

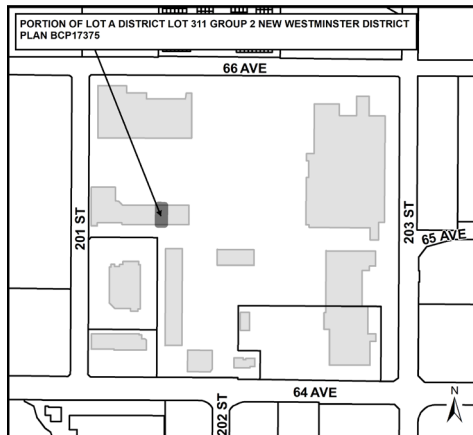
