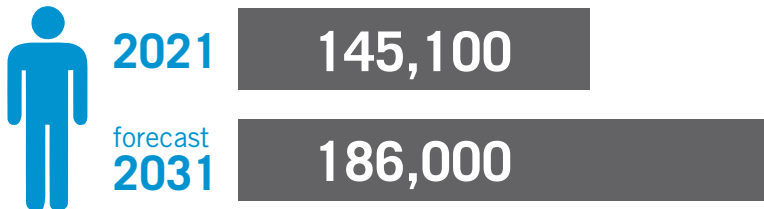


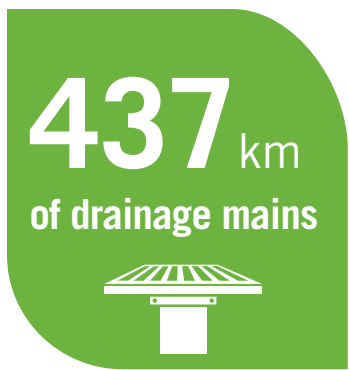
DRAINAGE INFRASTRUCTURE

The Township of Langley takes pride in providing and maintaining drainage infrastructure for our community. Drainage services and infrastructure are funded through taxes collected from residents and businesses.

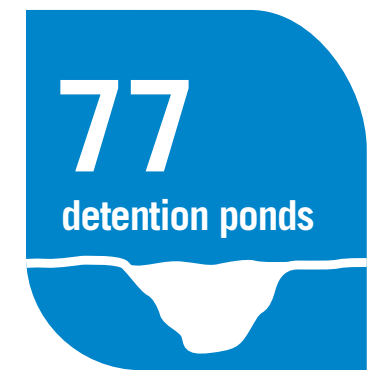


POPULATION GROWTH has increased demands on the drainage system and more funding is required to maintain aging infrastructure.

THE TOWNSHIP'S DRAINAGE SYSTEM has grown to include:

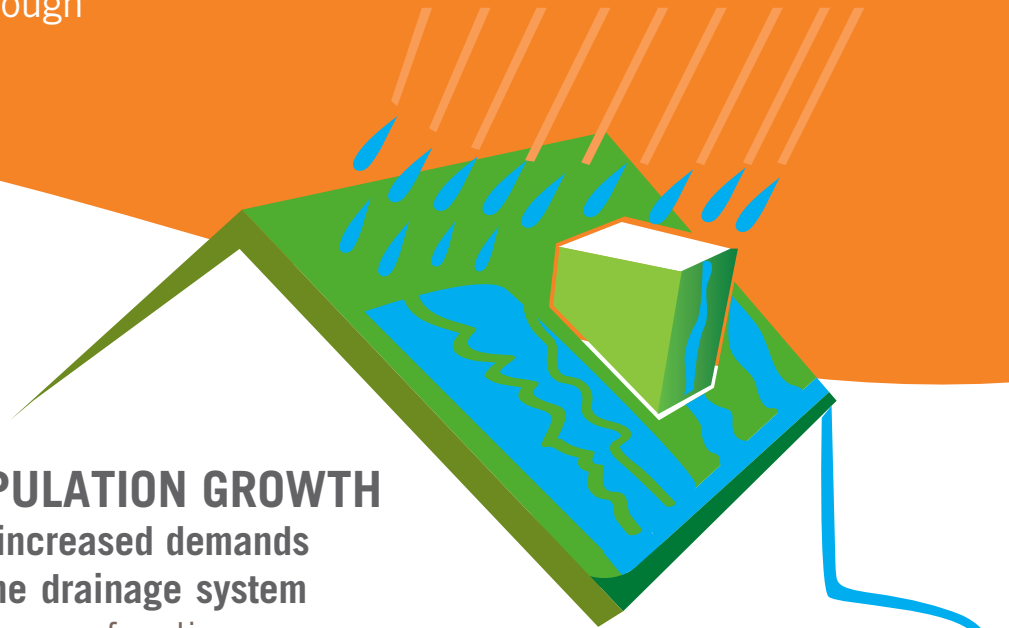


VALUE OF DRAINAGE INFRASTRUCTURE:
