NEIGHBOURHOOD INITIATIVE PROGRAM

The Township of Langley's Neighbourhood Initiative Program has been implemented in recognition of the need to assist communities in developing recreational opportunities **for their parks on a cost sharing basis with the Township**. The Township will contribute funds to a maximum of \$5,000 per project or 50% of the total cost of the project, whichever is the lesser.

A project must meet the following eligibility guidelines:

- is a capital construction project within a Township park, or within a designated neighbourhood park/school site, **or is a play equipment project at a private elementary school site where no public park/school site exists in the immediate neighbourhood**
- meets the quality standards as established and monitored by the Township
- is accessible to the general public at all reasonable hours **or as agreed upon hours for private lands**
- appeals to a realistic number of people in the community
- is a one time project (e.g. not a phased project) and is the only project the group is applying for assistance for in the current calendar year
- does not duplicate existing recreational facilities within the neighbourhood
- does not conflict with the Township's overall strategies and priorities for park development
- does not utilize other Township funding sources in the groups matching portion
- is completed within one year of funding approval
- does not have resources expended prior to project approval
