LANGLEY EMERGENCY PROGRAM VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

The Langley Emergency Program is a joint program between the City of Langley and the Township of Langley, where local residents learn how to keep their family safe and ready themselves for major emergencies. Our team members are dedicated to the resilience of their community and respond to help all citizens cope and move forward during such events.

To volunteer with our program, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be 16 years of age or older (*16-18 years: parent/guardian signature required*)
- Be in good health: Team members are considered 'first responders'
- Be comfortable with digital communication
- Can be available 24 hours, on short notice
- Provide a clear Police Information Check through the Langley RCMP

As a Langley Emergency Program volunteer, you are required to:

- Maintain confidentiality of all personal information that comes to you through involvement in the Program.
- Take part in exercises, training and operations in accordance with Program policies and procedures.
- Complete all mandatory training within 3 months, and maintain a level of competence to ensure member response readiness.
- Obey all traffic and other laws when responding for duty and while on duty.
- Not represent yourself as an agent of the City of Langley, the Township of Langley, or the Province of British Columbia.
- Not comment to the media (including posting on any social media platform) on any operations, present or past unless specifically given instruction to do so by Municipal Information Officer/Communication Officer.
- Not report for duty while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Never misrepresent yourself, your training or your skills to any organization or individual.
