Water park and pools open on Monday, July 16, 2018.

- Test the waters before July 16 by registering for a free test swim session.
- Swim lessons have started, register now for the next lesson set that begins Monday, July 16.
- Watch for the fall schedule to be released in August.

Arena

Ceremony is on Saturday, August 18, 2018.

- Public Skate sessions start Saturday, August 18.
- Ice user groups start pre-season training on Monday, August 20.
- Skating lessons start in September, watch for the schedule to be released soon.

Known as the **Pacific Zone**, the main pool area under the canopies include the 25 m pool, leisure pool, and hot tub, and includes access to the steam room and sauna.

What is the cost of admission?

Water park:

- Includes slides, all pools, river channel, and water play area
- One admission charge per water park session

Prices are listed in Canadian dollars, include tax, and are effective September 1, 2017.

* Family is a combination of parents, guardians, or grandparents with children under the age of 19 years who reside in the same household. Maximum two adults per family.

Pacific Zone:

- Includes 25 m pool, leisure pool, and hot tub – included in your admission to the Water Park or use your Go Active Pass (GAP).

May we stay all day at the Water Park (10:00am - 4:30pm)?

- A limited number of admissions for the afternoon session (1:30pm - 4:30pm) may be purchased at the time you pay for your morning session.

Are there any age restrictions?

- We recommend children aged 7 to 11 years be accompanied by a responsible person who is at least 16 years of age.
- All children less than 7 years of age must be closely supervised (within arm's reach at all times) by a responsible person who is at least 16 years of age. Maximum 3 children per person.

What beach items may I bring in to the Water Park?

- food and non-alcoholic beverages may be brought in to the water park (no glass containers)
- individual/small-sized coolers
- shade tents with footprint smaller than 4' x 6' (stakes are a hazard and not permitted)
- umbrellas
- collapsible chairs
- strollers
- personal flotation devices including PFDs, water wings, infant inflatables, and Hercules chest suits (swim suits with buoyancy features)

NOT PERMITTED

- personal water toys - we have plenty of fun and approved toys available for use
 - glass containers - throughout the aquatic facility including lobby and change rooms
 - alcohol
 - 10' x 10' pop-up tents

Is there food available on site?

Yes. Come check out the Triple O's food truck in the water park area.

What can I wear in the pools and on the water slides?

- Swim attire needs to be clean, not restrict your movement, or create a safety hazard to you or others.
- Clean indoor shoes or water sandals may be worn in all pools, river channel, and deck areas.

NOT PERMITTED

- Anything with exposed zippers, rivets, or buckles as they can damage the play equipment.
 - Footwear is not permitted on the water slides.
 - Street shoes are not permitted in the water park areas.
