


“Mid-construction blower door tests are an excellent way to correct weaknesses in the air barrier at an early stage”

Level of satisfaction with webinar:




“Seeing how [airtightness] testing was carried out helped with understanding what is required to make the building airtight.”

Has your airtightness knowledge increased?





Has your heat pump knowledge increased?




“Not easy to obtain a level 5. Many things need to change starting from design of building to details in order to make the installation easier”

Has the webinar increased your confidence in building to the Upper Steps of the Step Code?




Any fears or concerns building to Upper Steps?




“I would like to see more about cost issues. I have heard a lot of comments from perspective buyers who have purchased used houses because of new construction costs.”
